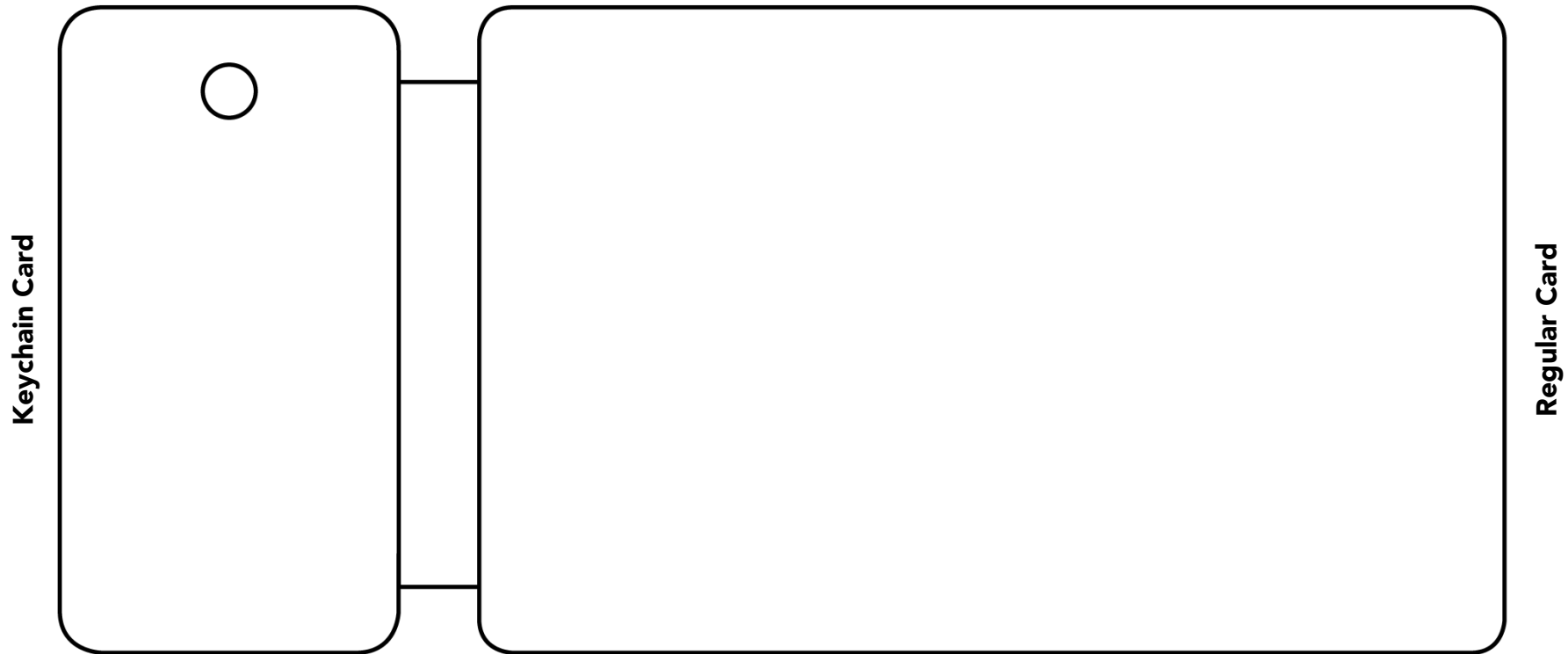

Design A Library Card Contest Rules and Regulations

1. Eligibility: a. The contest is open to all library patrons with a valid Huntley Area Public Library card. If you do not have one, drop in and get one to participate. b. Participants will be divided into two categories: Children (0-12 years old) and Teen/Adults (13 years and above).
2. Theme: a. Participants must create an original design for a library card using the form provided by the library. Find forms at any of the service desks during National Library Week April 7-13, 2024. b. The design should reflect the essence and values of the public library.
3. Prohibited Content: a. Participants are not allowed to use any licensed characters in their designs. b. Designs must not contain offensive or inappropriate content. c. The library shall be the sole judge in determining what is offensive or inappropriate content.
4. Submission Guidelines: a. Designs must be submitted on the form provided by the Huntley Area Public Library. b. Each participant is allowed only one entry. c. Submissions should be dropped off at the library's designated submission box on or before 5 p.m. Central Time on Saturday, April 13, 2024.
5. Judging Criteria: a. Creativity and Originality b. Adherence to Theme c. Artistic Skill d. Overall Impact
6. Prizes: a. Winners will be selected from each category. b. Prizes may include gift cards, corner bookstore vouchers, or other library-related items.
7. Judging Panel: a. A panel of judges, including library staff and an online poll available to the public, will evaluate the submissions. b. Library staff decisions are final.
8. Notification of Winners: a. Winners will be notified by phone or email. b. Winning designs may be displayed in the library or on the library's website. They will be made into actual library cards that should be available to the public during the month of September 2024. Credit for the winner of each category will be specified in the announcement of the contest winners, and in subsequent promotional materials such as the library's printed newsletter, website, social media, and displays.
9. Display of Entries: a. All submitted designs may be displayed in the library, on library property, on the library's website, and social media channels for public viewing.
10. Rights and Ownership: a. The library reserves the right to use the winning design for the official library card. b. The entries and the art submitted on the entry form become the sole property of the Huntley Area Public Library. Credit for the design and art will be given to the creator when necessary.
11. Deadline: a. The deadline for submission is 5 p.m. Central Time, Saturday, April 13, 2024.
