Loan Periods

3 week loan period: Books, Audiobooks, Music CDs, New Books, eBooks, Playaways and Magazines

2 week loan period: eBooks (1, 2 or 3 weeks), TV Series DVDs, Mobile Hotspots, Chromebooks

1 week loan period: "Hot Picks" books, Electricity usage monitor, Rokus, Video Games (limit 3), DVDs & Blu-Ray (not marked "new")

3 day loan period / limit 3 items:
"New" Blu-Ray & DVDs

Online Resources

Online resources are available through the library's website including eBooks, comic books, digital magazines, newspapers, music and movie streaming, genealogy resources, language learning, encyclopedias, and reference books. Access these resources at www.huntleylibrary.org.

Using the Online Catalog

Visit www.huntleylibrary.org to search for books, movies, music, and other items.

- Type title, author, or topic/phrase in the search box. Click "Search"
- Results will include items in the Huntley Area Public Library collection. Expand the search to other libraries by switching to "All Member Libraries"
- Narrow your search by using the options displayed on the left side of the page
- Place "holds" on items by clicking the "place hold" button
- Manage your account by clicking My Account
- Turn on reading history



Renewing & Reserving Items & Logging into Your Account

If eligible, items will auto-renew three days before their original due date.

All items may be renewed, except:

- "New" Movies
- "Hot Picks" Books
- Items on hold for other patrons

Place items on hold by visiting our online catalog. When a "hold" item is ready for pickup, you are notified by email, phone or text message based on your preference.

To change your notification preference, click "My Account", then "My Record", followed by "Contact & Information Preferences", or visit the Check-Out Desk.

All items may be reserved except:

- "New" Movies
- "Hot Picks" Books
- Reference Materials
- Roku & Mobile Hotspot devices holdable by Huntley patrons only

Your password will be the last 4 digits of the phone # on your account.

You may also access your account through an automated phone system, by calling 847.590.8706, and using your library card number.

The phone system will allow you to review:

- Checked out materials
- Items placed on "hold"
- Overdue materials
- Items available for renewal

Programs at the library

The library hosts programs for all ages. Programs generally require registration, and most are free, unless otherwise noted.

We Are a Fine Free Library!

Library users no longer pay fines for returning materials after their due date! You will see a due date on your receipt when you borrow items, and that's because yes, we do want them back. Everyone still needs to return items and keep them in good condition for the next borrower.

Please note these important Check-Out Policies:

- You will get reminder notices when an item is due for return
- If something is more than 2 weeks overdue, you will be unable to check out or use digital services until the item is returned
- If an item is more than 45 days past due, your library card account will be billed the replacement cost for your item. At this time a nonrefundable \$10 fee may be assessed. You may either return the item or pay the bill to replace it
- You will be charged for lost or damaged items
- If you locate a lost item within 30 days after paying to replace it, you may receive a refund

These steps ensure that everyone still returns their items in a timely manner and other people will have access to them.
