If you live in the Huntley Area Public Library District, including Huntley, parts of Lake in the Hills, Algonquin and surrounding areas, just bring in a photo ID and a bill that has been mailed to your current address. To find out if you live in the library district, please call 847-669-5386 & press 1. Your library card is issued free of charge.

You can use your library card at other libraries in Illinois.

Bring in your current and valid library card to the library you wish to use. Limitations may apply.

By the Numbers

The Huntley Area Public Library operates on a fiscal calendar from July 1st to June 30th of each year.

As of July 1, 2023 the library:

- owns nearly 118,000 items
- serves over 200,000 people annually
- lends over 700,000 items each year to residents
- answers more than 60,000 reference questions
- hosts more than 1,000 programs each year
- utilizes more than 150 dedicated volunteers each month, who work over 4,800 hours each year
- loans over 200,000 digital items per year



Library2Go

Library2Go is a free service making the library available to everyone in the community. If you cannot get to the library, the library can come to you.

This service is available to those with a qualifying condition (illness, injury, or lack of transportation) living within the library district. Participants can either request specific items, or choose to have items selected for them from a list of their preferences. Items are delivered to and picked up from the participant's home on a regular basis.
