

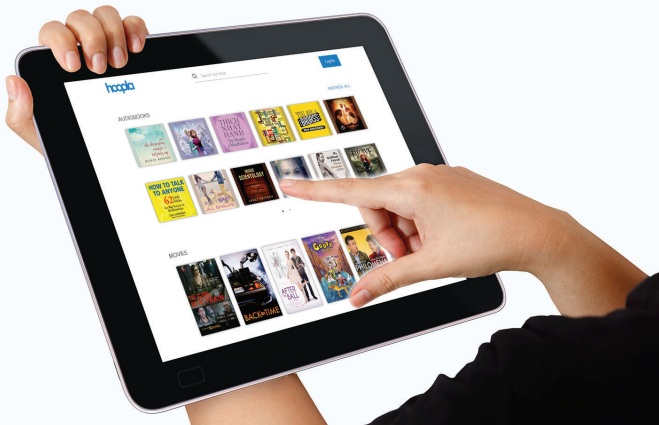

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What is hoopla?

hoopla is an app that brings digital content to life through streaming and downloading in different formats, including: movies, TV shows, audiobooks, eBooks and comic books.

Getting started: What I need to know to use hoopla

How do I get the app?

You'll need to visit hoopladigital.com to set up an account, and the apple, google play or amazon apps store to download the hoopla app.

What do I need to sign up for hoopla?

You must have a Huntley Area Public Library card. You will also need to create a hoopla account by providing a valid e-mail address and a password.

How do I borrow and play titles?

You can borrow titles through the hoopla digital mobile app or website. Once you select a title you can click on the Borrow button on the title details page. Once a title is borrowed, it will be added to your My Titles menu. From there, you can play the title on your mobile device or PC/Mac. Please note that in order to play content on your web browser, a plug-in called "Widevine" must be installed. Your web browser should prompt you to download this plug-in the first time you attempt to view content on your web browser.

How many items can I borrow a month and how long can items be checked out for?

You may borrow up to 5 items per month. Movie and TV content is available for 72 hours (3 days) after borrowing. Music albums are available for 7 days, and eBooks, comics and audiobooks are available for 21 days. All items will be automatically returned when the checkout time expires.
