



# Snow Pot People

## What's in the kit?

Terracotta pot  
White paint  
Paint brush  
Markers (black & orange)  
Pom poms  
Pipe cleaner  
Washi tape

## You will also need

Glue (school or craft glue or hot glue gun)

## Getting started

Assemble your supplies and protect your work surface and clothing.

## Instructions

- Paint the outside of your terracotta pot with the white paint – it may need more than one coat of paint to cover it completely. Optional: Paint the inside of your pot (if you have paint left over). Allow to dry.
- Wrap a length of washi tape along rim of the pot. You can pre-measure it, or just pull from the roll as you wrap.
- Decide where you want your snow person's face to be and how you want it to look (you can practice on scratch paper before you commit, and/or sketch it with pencil on the pot before going over with marker), then draw it on the pot.
- Bend your pipe cleaner to make a U shape and glue the ends of it to the sides of the pot (this is the headband for the snow person's ear muffs). Allow glue to dry.
- Glue the pom poms – one on each side – covering the tips of the pipe cleaner (these are the ear muffs). Allow glue to dry.

Other ideas: Make a hat for your snow pot person instead of earmuffs. You can use a sock or knit/crochet a small hat if you know how. Add rosy cheeks with red paint or marker. Make a cloth scarf instead of using washi tape.
