

Getting Started with Libby

- The first time you open the Libby app, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with your library card.
- Titles that are available will say "Borrow." If no copies are available, titles will say "Place Hold" and you will be added to the wait list.
- When you find an available title, tap **Borrow** to check it out or tap on the cover to learn more about the title.
- After tapping **Borrow** a comfirmation page will appear. You can change your lending period by tapping on the # **of Days**. Then tap **Borrow** to confirm the checkout.
- Start reading or listening by tapping Open Book, Open Audiobook, or Open Magazine. Or tap Keep Browsing to search for more titles to check out.
- Check out up to 10 titles at a time and place up to 12 holds.
- When you are notified your hold is available, go to your **Shelf**, tap **Holds**, and tap **Borrow** for your book.

Helpful Hints

- When browsing Digital Library of Illinois:
 - Tap + **Preferences** to modify your default search settings.
- In your Shelf tap on "Manage Loan" to:
 - Renew a title two days before it's due. If there are holds you will be placed on the wait list. Return a title early.
- To change text size in a book, tap the center of the screen, then tap A

 Drag the **Text Scale** slider to change text size.
- Access the Libby menu by tapping on: \equiv
 - Tap "Manage Cards" to add another library card.
 - Tap "Add Library" if you belong to another library.
 - Tap "Get Some Help" to find solutions to common problems.
